HEALTH SCREENING @ EKUPONG

DENTAL CARE (TOOTHBRUSH AND PASTE DISTRIBUTION)
SANITARY PAD DISTRIBUTION

As part of its unwavering commitment to education, health, and community development, Prime Harmony Foundation embarked on a donation and outreach initiative that impacted four schools: Denkyira Presby Basic, Enyan Denkyira D/A Basic, Enyan Denkyira Methodist Basic School, Essiam Catholic Basic School. This effort was designed to support underprivileged students by addressing both their educational and health needs in a holistic manner.

During the outreach, the Foundation distributed close to 1,000 exercise books, pens, pencils, and other school materials. These supplies were shared among hundreds of pupils, ensuring that each student received essential tools to enhance their learning experience. For many of these children, such support lifts a significant burden off their families and encourages regular school attendance and participation.

In addition to educational supplies, the Foundation conducted free health screenings for over 200 pupils, offering basic check-ups and health consultations. This health drive emphasized early detection and awareness, helping to instill a culture of personal care and hygiene among the students. Alongside this, over 200 toothbrushes and tubes of toothpaste were distributed, promoting oral hygiene as a vital part of personal wellbeing.

Recognizing the unique needs of adolescent girls, Prime Harmony Foundation also distributed sanitary pads to several young women in the schools. This act not only supports menstrual hygiene but also fosters confidence and reduces absenteeism caused by a lack of sanitary resources. For many of the beneficiaries, this gesture was both timely and deeply appreciated.

The donation event was met with enthusiasm and gratitude from school authorities, students, and community members. Teachers expressed heartfelt thanks for the support, noting that the Foundation's efforts would leave a lasting impact on the academic performance and health awareness of their pupils.
